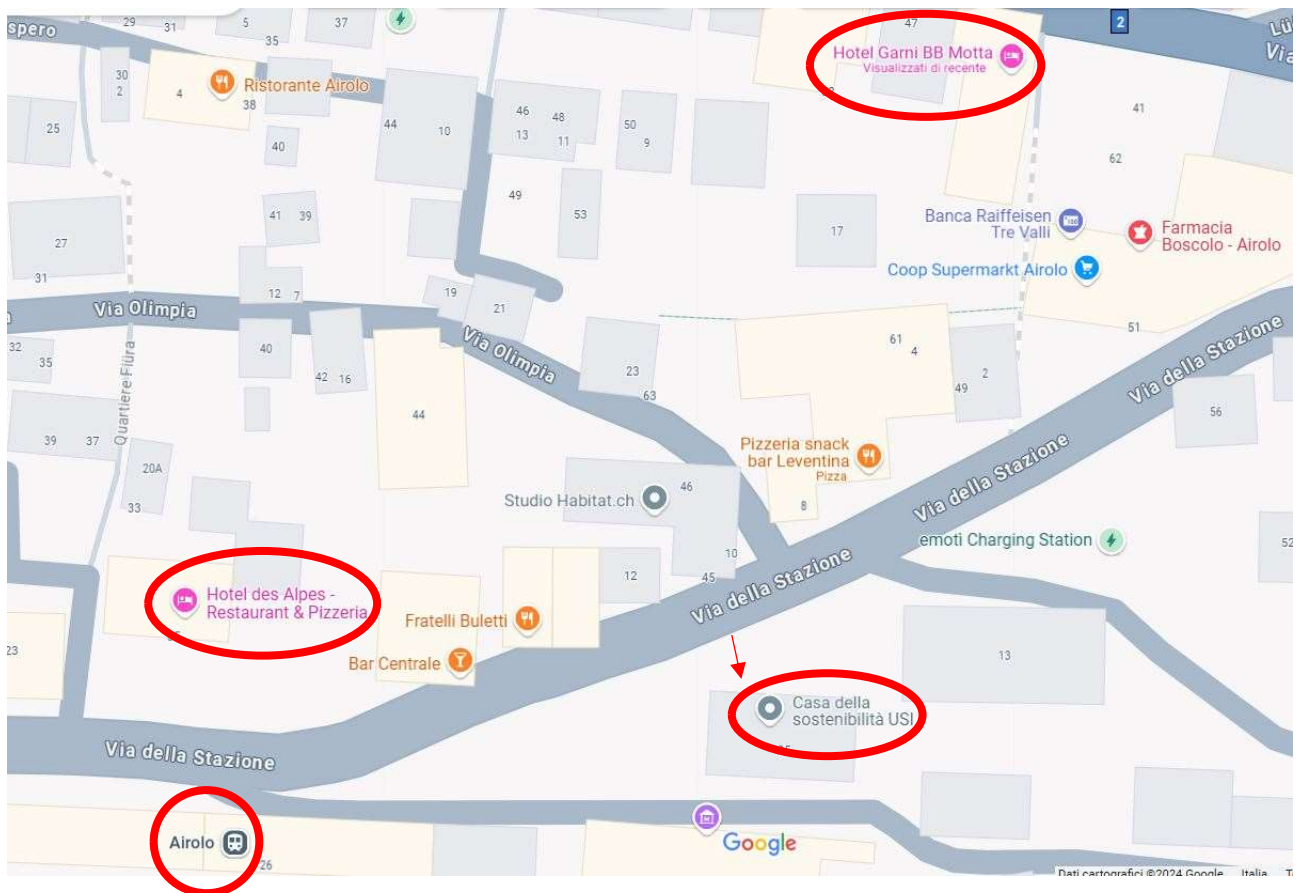
Locations
