REQUEST ARTICLE VIA LIBRARY

This is not always free, but often a fast option, and often much cheaper than buying it from the publisher. USI covers the costs for its affiliates: ask your library for advice.

FREE FULL TEXTS

Use browser plug-ins (such as Unpaywall, Open Access Button, Google Scholar, or CORE Discovery) to find articles in non-commercial repositories.

REQUEST ARTICLE VIA AUTHOR OR RESEARCH COMMUNITY

Ask the author to send you the article (e.g. via ResearchGate). This may not be the fastest, but is a well-used route to access publications.

HASHTAG #ICANHAZPDF

On social media platforms, use the hashtag [#icanhazpdf](https://twitter.com/icanhazpdf) together with a link to the requested publication; if somebody has access, they can send you the article.
